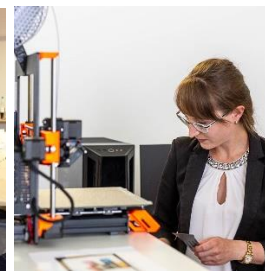

The development of international cooperation is one of Škoda Auto Vysoká škola main priorities. A key activity is the creation of a closely cooperating network of centres that focus on the collaboration of industry and business practice, on globalised branches and markets, embracing the goals and values shared by Škoda Auto Vysoká škola. This development is greatly supported by active participation of academics from specialised departments, seminar activities at partner schools abroad, guest speaker lectures, joint research projects, conferences and seminars. An integral part of successful cooperation is motivated students who actively participate in projects of international cooperation.

With a view to enhancing its international study programmes, Škoda Auto Vysoká Škola has been providing a common **Double-Degree** programme with University of Applied Sciences Upper Austria since the academic year 2010/2011 as well as with Seinäjoki University of Applied Sciences. Since 2021 the university offers its 3<sup>rd</sup> double-degree programme with University of Applied Sciences Dresden and since 2023 the university offers its 4<sup>th</sup> double-degree programme with Katholieke Hogeschool VIVES Zuid vzw.

The university is an honoured holder of Erasmus Charter for Higher Education 2021-2027, which is in accordance with Škoda Auto University Internationalization strategy. **ECHE** contains fundamental principles to be respected by HEI when participating in Erasmus+ programme.

In 2014, Škoda Auto Vysoká škola successfully completed the accreditation process of the American Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs, obtaining the prestigious **ACBSP** business program accreditation under all its standards and criteria.

In 2016, Škoda Auto Vysoká škola obtained accreditation from the Czech Association of MBA Schools (**CAMBAS**). The accreditation allows Škoda Auto University to develop and provide MBA lifelong-learning programmes.



**The Online MBA programme** is a lifelong learning programme designed to meet the needs and perspectives of professionals in early career stages, who are motivated to self-study through virtual learning. The goal of the programme is to develop knowledge and skills to confront current challenges of the management profession.
